SembShip successfully completed another major repair for oil major BP Shipping of UK. The **British Spirit** entered SembShip in late February 1998 and underwent one month of substantial repairs. Major repairs carried out on the 117,353 dwt tanker included hull cleaning and painting, steelwork renewal in the tanks, ballast tank hatch repairs, renewal of deck cargo line couplings and pipes as well as renewal of pipe insulation. In addition, the Yard's experienced team from the mechanical department carried out modification to the vessel's main engine exhaust valve and our automation team installed the main engine oil mist detector. The firefighting equipment was also repaired and upgraded to meet stringent safety regulations. The BP supervising team led by Mr Terry Bass and Mr Hal Preston were very happy with the overall repairs, especially the excellent performance of the repair team led by our Shiprepair Manager, Mr C.T.Chua.
