Successful completion of Brotojoyo, another milestone achievement!

In July 2006, Sembawang Shipyard recorded another milestone achievement in the area of offshore conversion with the successful completion of FPSO Brotojoyo, for our FCC partner, TESMA (Singapore) and owner of the FPSO, PT Berlian Laju Tankers (BLT), one of Indonesia's leading shipowners. The Brotojoyo is BLT's first FPSO launched and is currently deployed in the Salawati Oil Field in Papua / Irian in Indonesian waters.

The major conversion contract, under the joint collaboration of TESMA (Singapore)-BLT-PT Sillo-Sembawang Shipyard commenced in December 2005 and was completed under an impressive seven-month duration. The workscope included the installation of 400 tons of process units, metering units, chain stoppers and mooring winches, fabrication of loading & offloading platform, flare tower, helideck with structures, upgrading

and installation of boilers instrumentation, electrical, safety, fire & gas and emergency shut down and telecommunication systems. New generators, fresh water generators and new tank gauging system were installed. More than 1600 tons of steel, 40,000 metres of electrical cables and approx 2500 metres of piping works were renewed. Major overhaul of main engines and machinery systems were also done. Working closely with owners' team, the combined expertise, knowledge, skills and capabilities had met the stringent safety

and quality standards of end users, PetroChina and BP MIGAS.

Owners held a grand naming ceremony for Brotojoyo on 7 July 2006 jointly with PT Berlian Laju Tankers (BLT) to celebrate the company's inauguration into the lucrative offshore FPSO market. Graced by Lady Sponsor, Ibu Anggraeni Surya, wife of Pak Hadi Surya, BLT's President Commissioner, many of their VIP guests had flown in specially for the event including representatives from BP MIGAS,
