Sembawang Shipyard is pleased to usher in the 88th vessel from our long-term partner, EMS Shipmanagement (ex-*TESMA*), part of the Eitzen Group of Norway in February 2007. The 28,027 dwt chemical tanker Siteam Anja is the auspicious 88th vessel that we have repaired for major Norwegian shipowner, Eitzen Group since the repair of its first vessel, Siboto in our shipyard in March 1982.

One of our longest FCC partners, our FCC partnership agreement was signed with EMS Shipmanagement in 2002.
