Sea Asia, Singapore

In April 2007, jointly with SembCorp Marine, we participated in Sea Asia 2007, a major shipping exhibition and conference held at the Suntec City Convention Centre. The exhibition was supported by the Singapore Maritime Foundation (SMF) and was officiated by His Excellency, President S R Nathan.

Jointly with our other colleagues from SembCorp Marine, we hosted a successful tea reception for our customers and business associates from the marine industry. Sea Asia 2007 attracted more than 7,000 visitors from 42 countries worldwide and these included some 1,000 delegates who attended the three-day conference, which covered a wide array of shipping issues / topics such as global shipping, ship finance in Asia, LNG and offshore markets, marine insurance, chartering and ship brokering.

Offshore Technology Conference, Houston (USA)

In May 2007, Sembawang Shipyard was part of SembCorp Marine's delegation that took part in the annual Offshore Technology Conference (OTC) held in Houston, Texas, USA. This event is the world's largest offshore event with total exhibition space of nearly 530,000 square feet, or the size of 13 football fields. This year's event attracted a record 25-year high attendance of 67,155 offshore professionals from 110 countries, including nearly 2,400 companies from more than 30 countries. Not surprising as the last two years have seen record sales revenues from the offshore shipbuilding and shiprepair sectors at a time when the offshore industry is experiencing never-seen-before peak activities in deepwater drilling and exploration.

Throughout the exhibition period, interesting conference papers and technical presentations were delivered, with special sessions focused on significant industry topics such as the emerging areas for offshore development which offered attendees the opportunity to learn the latest technology in oil and natural gas resources mining from deepwaters.

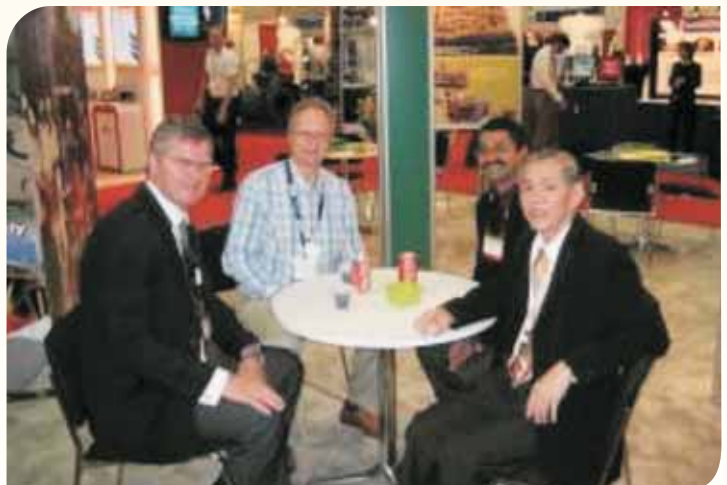

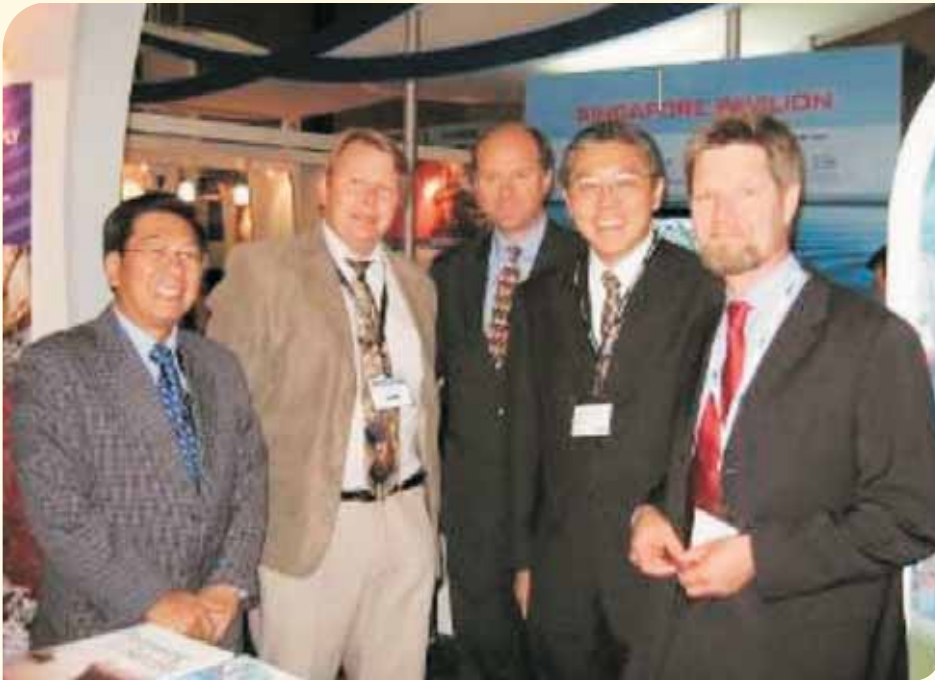

Nor-Shipping 2007, Oslo, Norway

In June 2007, jointly with SembCorp Marine, Sembawang Shipyard was part of the big Singapore delegation that participated in Nor-Shipping 2007 led by Mrs. Lim Hwee Hua, Minister of State for Finance and Transport. Organised by Norway Trade Fairs, this 4-day biennial event is touted as one of the biggest and most successful maritime exhibitions in the world. This year's exhibition was officiated by King Harald of Norway and attracted close to 20,000 delegates from 80 countries and more than 800 companies from over 40 countries.

As one of the world's leading maritime hub, the Singapore pavilion was very well visited and a special 'Singapore Nite' reception was held for major business partners and customers of all participating companies including SembCorp Marine and Sembawang Shipyard. Currently, more than 60 Norwegian shipping related companies have made Singapore their Asian headquarters.
