Sembawang Shipyard Signs Favoured Customer Contract (FCC) with ASP Ship Management Group, UK

On 1st June 2005, Sembawang Shipyard secured another major refit partner with the signing of a long-term Favoured Customer Contract (FCC) with ASP Ship Management Group (UK). The contract, signed in London by Mr John Bowering, Chief Executive of ASP Ship Management Group and Ms Lee-Lin Wong, Executive Director and General Manager of Sembawang Shipyard Pte Ltd, commits the retrofitting and dry-docking of its fleet of owned / operated / managed vessels to Sembawang Shipyard for the foreseeable future.

ASP Ship Management is a long time customer of Sembawang Shipyard and prior to the signing of the FCC, the ASP's distinctive blue and white funnel is already a familiar sight to the shipyard's workers. An FCC relationship does not evolve overnight but is cemented over a period of time when trust and commitment are established between both partners. We are therefore pleased that ASP has taken the bold step to develop this partnership relationship of trust and commitment further.

ASP Ship Management has operating offices in the major shipping centres of Australia, Singapore, India, Germany,

Norway and Finland. Currently, ASP Ship Management Group manages a huge diverse fleet of more than 124 vessels comprising owners from oil majors and large independents to niche players. ASP and SSPL have successfully collaborated on many challenging and complex projects which require strong project management,

HSE and quality processes and teamwork.

In recent months, the shipyard successfully redelivered the 40,525 dwt chemical tanker *Scottish Wizard* in July 2005, managed from ASP Australia and 3 other vessels i.e. *Endeavour* for ASP Singapore, *Juniper* and *Jasmine* for ASP Australia. With the signing of this FCC,



an estimated 8 to 10 vessels from ASP Ship Management Group are expected to drydock in Sembawang Shipyard annually.

Besides our new FCC partner ASP Ship Management Group, Sembawang Shipyard has alliance partnerships with Shell International Trading and Shipping Company Limited (UK), BP Shipping (UK), BHP Billiton (Australia) and Jo Tankers AS (Norway) as well as long term contracts with Alaska Tanker Company (USA), TESMA Group (Norway), V. Ships (Monaco), Tecto B.V.(Belgium), TMT Company (Taiwan) and Northwest Shelf Shipping (Australia), all of which are internationally renowned shipping companies. ⚓
