



Sembawang Shipyard @ Posidonia 2004

In early June 2004, Sembawang Shipyard participated in Posidonia 2004, one of the world's largest maritime exhibitions. Held in Piraeus, Greece, one of the biggest maritime hubs, the exhibition attracted some 1,650 exhibitors from 74 countries. Sembawang is a regular exhibitor in this biennial event and this year, our representatives at the exhibition were Mr Jimmy Ho, Commercial Manager (Sales), Mr Sin Fook Mun, Deputy Estimating Manager and our Greek agents from Interyards S/A., Mr George Sitinas, Mr Dimitrios Vassiliou and Mr George Poulakis.

This year's show attracted some 20,000 visitors from the global maritime fraternity including ship owners, ship operators, ship managers, shipbrokers, ship builders, equipment and machinery manufacturers, maritime insurers and other related service providers.

The exhibition was officially declared open by Greece's Prime Minister Mr Costas Karamanlis and was attended by many dignitaries including the various European ministers involved in shipping, transportation and commercial activities. Singapore's Minister of State for Health and Transport,

Dr Balaji Sadasivan and Rear Admiral Lui Tuck Yew, Chief Executive of Maritime Port Authority of Singapore were also present at the exhibition.

Our exhibition stand was well attended by our customers from all parts of the world, especially our Greek customers, who specially came by our stand to catch up with our representatives. Greece is one of Sembawang's biggest markets and we have traditionally enjoyed strong support from the Greek ship owners and ship managers. We successfully repaired 5 Greek vessels namely *Angelia P*, *Aliki*, *Evelyn*, *Vergina 1* and *Fjord Champion* between January to May 2004 and we are expecting another 8 Greek vessels to drydock in our shipyard between June and July 2004. ⚓
